After college, Todd began his professional work in clinical and medical research in the Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine at Albany Medical Center. In 2001, Todd became the Executive Director and General Manager of Becton Dickinson Biosciences and went on to work for various medical research and technology companies including Applied Biosystems, Guava Technologies and Agilent Technologies, Inc where Todd has worked since 2009. Currently, Todd serves as the Vice President and General Manager of Agilent's Cell Analysis Division. Todd's career has allowed him to travel not only the country but the world, going to places like China, Germany, Japan and Ireland, focusing on advancing medical research and developing tools to help advance cancer diagnostics and treatment. At Agilent, Todd has built an organization through a series of acquisitions devoted to developing tools that help diagnose and treat various forms of immune system deficiencies and

cancer. Recently, these tools have helped advance research on Sars-CoV-2, the virus which causes the COVID-19 infection, to help in the detection of the virus and development of the vaccines. Today, Todd and his teams' work continues to pioneer advances in immuno-, cell and gene therapy development. Todd's colleagues know him as a passionate individual, driven to always want to make a difference and continue learning. Todd is also known for his philanthropy. In the past, Todd has participated in AIDS/LifeCycle, a seven-day cycling tour from San Francisco to Los Angeles that raises funds for AIDS research.
